3. INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS

STUDENT EXCHANGES

- In the Lifelong Learning Programme, the KAHO Sint-Lieven agreed bilateral agreements with more than 100 European partner universities and colleges. Also other European programs (eg Leonardo da Vinci) supply many other partners. The policy is designed to optimize the cooperation with existing partners, rather than attracting new partners.

STUDENT EXCHANGES

In total, in the academic year 2010-2011:
160 OUTGOING students, who are divided as follows among the various programs:

- Erasmus study (study at university college or university) and placement (traineeship): 112 students
- Development cooperation: 34 students
- Erasmus Belgica (exchange with Wallonia): 5 students
- Other (bilateral exchanges without scholarship and exchanges less than 3 months): 14 students
